30 DAY PUBLIC COMMENT & PUBLIC HEARING-STATE IMPLEMENTATION PLAN PURSUANT TO THE CLEAN AIR ACT

Notice is hereby given to the general public that the Guam Environmental Protection Agency (Guam EPA) intends to submit a 2020 Sulfur Dioxide Emissions Inventory of Guam to the United States Environmental Protection Agency for inclusion into Guam's State Implementation Program (SIP).

Pursuant to 40 CFR § 51.102, Guam EPA issues this 30 day public notice to seek public comment on the Guam EPA's intent to submit this Inventory to US EPA for approval and inclusion in Guam's SIP. This notice also serves to notify the general public that a public hearing will be held to seek public comment on the same Guam EPA intent.
